Dear friends of Saints Peter and Paul and Philomena,

Last week the liturgical calendar brought us the autumn Ember Days, traditionally observed the Wednesday, Friday and Saturday following the feast of the Holy Cross. These quarterly penitential days are like a small Lent, inviting us to rekindle the spirit of penance out of love for God. The Ember Days (also called the 'Quarter Tense' Days, since they fall four times a year, during each season), formerly days of fast and abstinence, were instituted as an occasion to pray for the fruits of the earth and for the sanctification of the clergy, since the major orders were traditionally conferred on Ember Saturdays. St Leo the Great (440-461) and St Gregory the Great (590-604) have left us some memorable sermons preached for the Ember Days in Rome. Although the fast is no longer obligatory on these days, they are still a good opportunity for us to pray and do penance in our families, to ask God for more vocations and to pray for the perseverance of priests and religious. The next Ember Days fall in the third week of Advent. O Lord, send us many holy priests and religious vocations!
