Dear friends of Saints Peter and Paul and Philomena,

Today, on the penultimate Sunday of October, the Church observes 'Mission Sunday'. At Mass on this day, after the Collect of Sunday, the celebrant adds a second Collect for the Propagation of the Faith: "O God, who willest that all men should be saved, and come to the knowledge of the truth: send forth, we beseech thee, labourers into thy harvest, and enable them to speak the word with all boldness; that thy word may run and be glorified, and that all nations may know thee, the one true God, and him whom thou hast sent, even Jesus Christ, thy Son our Lord, who liveth and reigneth with thee, in the unity of the Holy Ghost, ever one God, world without end." Pope Pius XI instituted Mission Sunday in 1926, as a day of prayer for the spread of the true faith and for the growth of the missions, and our Pope Francis continues to insist on this necessity. The Church is missionary by her very nature. At the Ascension, Our Lord gave his Apostles the mission of bringing the faith to the world, which then as now, lay enveloped in darkness and desperation. Since a good missionary must first be an excellent contemplative, let us ask ourselves whether we seek to pass on the faith by being prayerfully united to Our Lord?
