Dear friends of Saints Peter and Paul and Philomena,

Every day in the Canon of the Mass, the priest prays for those *qui nos praecesserunt cum signo fidei et dormiunt in somno pacis*, 'who are gone before us with the sign of faith and who repose in the sleep of peace'. Praying for those who have died – especially our deceased family, friends and benefactors – is an important duty of charity. The Church, as we know, is often called 'the communion of saints': the mysterious fellowship between the Church Militant on earth, the Church Triumphant in heaven and the Church Suffering in purgatory. The month of November is dedicated in a special way to the poor souls in purgatory. It is possible to gain a plenary indulgence for the poor souls every day in the week following All Souls Day by visiting a cemetery and praying for the dead. The Book of Machabees, in an excerpt read at the anniversary Mass of the dead, reminds us: 'it is a holy and wholesome thought to pray for the dead, that they may be loosed from their sins'. This month let us make a special effort to intercede for the dead, by pious visits to their graves, in our family rosary, by having Masses offered. Praying for the most forgotten souls in purgatory is also a good way to gain new intercessors in heaven!

WHICH MASS IS IT TODAY? Depending on the date of Easter, the calendar can include from 23 to 28 Sundays after Pentecost in a given year. The Roman Missal contains 6 Sundays after Epiphany and 24 Sundays after Pentecost. When there are more then 24 Sundays after Pentecost in a given year, the Propers of the 23rd Sunday (Introit *Dicit Dominus*) are repeated, and the Collects, Epistle and Gospel are taken from the remaining Sundays after Epiphany – today, for example, from the 4th Sunday after Epiphany.
