Dear friends of Saints Peter and Paul and Philomena,  
Please allow me to thank each of you for your help in the continuing restoration of our beloved Shrine church. In the last two weeks, the work started on the church: a recent structural investigation, requested and granted by Heritage Lottery Funds, was done. We were delighted to see a cherry picker in the church! A generous parishioner donated 8 new lights for the sanctuary: the cherry picker was very useful in replacing the old units from the ceiling. The boilers have been cleaned in preparation for winter and the benches infested with woodworm treated. The bad news came from the organ, very severely infested with woodworms: therefore I had to ask a professional to remove the action of the organ, in order to treat the full organ, the floor of the loft, and replace several pieces of wood. Please God we will someday be able to buy a new, modern action for our organ! Our altar to St Philomena is now decorated with beautiful red hangings: I am still looking for a suitable statute (roughly three feet tall) of our protectress. Our Charity Shop was again a great success, despite the damp weather: we raised about £880, a very significant help to match the grant (£35,000). I will try to give you news from our restoration in the weekly newsletters. Oremus pro invicem.
