Dear friends of Saints Peter and Paul and Philomena,

In preparation for the upcoming synod on marriage and the family, the bishops of England and Wales are inviting Catholics, clergy and laity, to answer some questions related to living out the teaching of the Church on a variety of life and family-related issues (see back for web address). Although some media outlets have misleadingly suggested that the time might be right to change the Church's perennial teachings on these questions, we know that, far from being arbitrary and subject to change, the Church's teaching on marriage and the family comes from God himself, author of human nature and of the institution of marriage. *Marriage is the lifelong union of one man and one woman, ordered by its very nature to the bearing and education of children.* Among baptised Christians, this natural institution has been elevated by Our Lord Jesus Christ to the dignity of sacrament: a source of grace and a sign of the self-giving union between the Incarnate Word and his Bride the Church. Even though dramatic social changes – including most recently the imposition of same-sex 'marriage' in many Western countries – have made the Church's teaching incomprehensible to many people, the key is not to change the message, but to help people – with the help of God's grace – to live up to it.
