Dear Friends of Ss Peter, Paul and Philomena,

“But if I, by the finger of God, cast out devils, doubtless the kingdom of God is come upon you.” Our Lord refuted those who accused Him of casting out devils by the help of Beelzebub. He refutes the accusation first by showing its absurdity, which if true, would mean that Satan was working against himself and his own interests. Secondly, our Lord refers to the well-known practices of their own Jewish exorcists, who were also credited with the power of expelling demons by appealing to the help of God. If divine assistance was given them, why should it be denied to the Christ? Thirdly, our Lord cites what happens among men, when a stronger man overcomes one who is weaker, drives him from his house, and takes possession of his goods. Since the Christ has done this very thing by casting out the devil from the possessed man, He must be more powerful than the devil. Fourthly, He appeals to reason, for it is unreasonable to say that two opposites can be working in harmony: the devil who is evil and seeks the ruin of souls, and Christ who is good and seeks the salvation of souls. (Commentary of St Thomas Aquinas)

“Blessed is the womb that bore thee...Yea rather blessed are they who hear the word of God and keep it.” Our Lord’s response to the devout woman in the crowd does not imply any contradiction. Before conceiving Christ, The Word, in her womb, the Blessed Virgin Mary had already conceived The Word in Her Immaculate Heart. Thus, our Lady heard and kept the word of God more than any other creature, surpassing the blessed who hear and keep the word of God. Let us ask the Blessed Virgin to pray to Her Divine Son to augment in us the divine virtue of faith that we too may conceive the Christ in our heart. In this way, unlike those who accused our Lord, we may hear the word of God and keep it. God bless you,
