“Dear Friends of Ss Peter, Paul, and Philomena,

Laetare Jerusalem...” This Sunday in Lent is a special occasion for joy as we look forward to the Resurrection of our Lord. This joy is special in that, during a time of penance, all our sufferings which we join to our Lord’s Passion and Death also participate in His Resurrection. Apart from the merits of Christ, none of our penances or sacrifices have any meaning. In the Gospel today, our Lord feeds the multitude in performing the miracle of the multiplication of the loaves and fish. When our Lord asked some His disciples about what was to be done to feed the multitude, Philip responded that they had not enough money to provide and Andrew responded that the loaves and fish already on hand were insufficient to feed so many. According to St Thomas Aquinas, Philip here represents the natural wisdom of the world before Christ and Divine Revelation and that Andrew represents the supernatural wisdom of the Mosaic Law before Christ and the New Law. Neither natural wisdom nor the Judaism alone are sufficient without the intervention and mediation of Christ and the merits He won in His Passion, Death, and Resurrection. Our Lord, in the multiplication of the loaves and fish, reminds us that the physical world of His creation is essentially good, even with the disorder caused by sin. In His physical suffering, death, and resurrection constantly linked with His Divine Nature, our Lord renews His creation, making it possible as an instrument for our sanctification. The Catholic Church is essentially the Church of the Incarnation, in which natural wisdom and the Old Law find their fulfillment and source of joy in suffering, dying, and rising with Christ.
