Dear friends of the Shrine,

We had the great opportunity last Sunday to celebrate the Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and renew on this occasion our consecration to the Lord. I was very happy to bring all of you and all your intentions to the foot of the Blessed Sacrament. 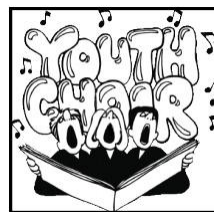
