Dear friends of Ss Peter Paul and Philomena,

The Gospel of 4th Sunday after Easter shows a side of the justice of God : “When the Holy Ghost comes, He will convince the world of sin, and of justice and of judgment”. God is just according to Our Lord’s witness and the history of the Old Testament. God is our judge and will judge our actions and behaviour at the end of our life (“Each man receives his eternal retribution in his immortal soul at the very moment of his death, in a particular judgment that refers his life to Christ”, CCC 1022). Judging means that God knows perfectly the secret of all hearts, all souls and all minds, He knows clearly our intention in our actions and behaviour. We do not need to fear this moment because He will teach us all the truth and will show us what we are really. If we have been faithful and if we have achieved our whole life for His love, we will be perfectly and eternally happy with Him in Heaven, maybe after a last and necessary purification in the Purgatory. As Saint Thomas Aquinas underlines in his treaty about God, His justice is always linked to His Mercy : justice is giving to everyone a reward, but we can’t merit to see God face to face. This gift exceeds our natural capacity, even if we were created for Heaven. The grace helps our weak nature to reach the supernatural reward and vision of God. This help is not merited : God, liberally, over a strict justice and by pure mercy, vouchsafes Glory our human nature. Justice and mercy always “walk” together in God’s plan of Salvation. God bless,
