Dear Friends of SS Peter & Paul & Philomena

In today's Gospel, our Lord says to the Jews « I seek not My own glory ; there is one that seeketh and judgeth... It is My Father that glorifieth Me... » Also, in the introit, the psalmist prefigures the Christ in saying « Judge me, O God, and distinguish my cause... » Only the Sacrifice of Christ in His Passion and Death, which He offered « unspotted before God, » is worthy to be judged by God since it is most pure and is not for its own glory. The Jews who were questioning our Lord did not believe that He was the Messiah. On the contrary, they tried to explain His supernatural power as coming from the devil. Jesus, shows us His love towards sinners through His patience towards their repeated accusations. According to the commentary of St Thomas Aquinas, Jesus could have shown the folly of their accusations by revealing to them their very own public and private sins.

Sometimes in our own life, in defending ourselves against accusations, the natural and good desire for preserving our good name can easily turn into unjust retaliation. God is our judge and will distinguish our cause. We must, like our Lord, be sure that we are charitable to our neighbor by being patient and humble, not seeking our own glory. Even against false accusations, we pay our debt first to the truth, and then afterwards to humility. In this way we can pray with the psalmist « Judica me Deus, et discerne causam meam de gente non sancta. » To be patient is to suffer, and in suffering we can suffer with Christ in His Passion. If we seek our own glory and do not join our suffering to the sufferings of our Lord, then He will say to us as He said to the Jews « you are not of God. » Let us enter in to the Passion of our Lord by patiently enduring the sufferings which He allows for our own sanctification.
