O God, who, by a wonderful order and disposition, hast been pleased to manifest the dispensation of our salvation even by means of things insensible; grant, we beseech Thee, that the devout hearts of Thy faithful may profitably understand what is mystically signified when on this day the multitude, inspired by heavenly illumination, went forth to meet their Redeemer, and spread branches of palm and olive at His feet. And we also, with full faith, keeping this as done and signified, humbly beseech Thee, O Holy Lord, Father Almighty, Eternal God, through the same Jesus Christ our Lord, that in Him and through Him, whose members Thou hast desired to make us, we may become victorious over the empire of death, and may deserve to be partakers of His glorious resurrection.
