Dear friends of Saints Peter and Paul and Philomena,
Ad te levavi animam meam, “Towards Thee have I lifted up my soul: my God, I trust in Thee.” With these words of the Introit of today’s Mass begins a new liturgical year. We must fear neither the power of the devil nor the number of our sins if we believe in God. The liturgy of this First Sunday of Advent reminds us how important it is to dwell in God’s grace. Our own death, of which we are so conscious during the month of November, cannot be a source of unreasonable fear, since it is the introduction to another, eternal life. Our personal contact and intimacy with our Lord is the heart of our hope and supernatural strength, as Pope Francis reminded us last Wednesday during the general audience at St Peter’s Square: “We die as we live: if our lives were lived in loving union with God, we will be able to abandon ourselves serenely and confidently into his hands at the moment of our death. Our Lord frequently tells us to be watchful, knowing that our life in this world is a preparation for the life to come.” The liturgical time of Advent is thus a time of preparation for our personal encounter with Christ not only at Christmas, but also “now and at the hour of our death.” Canon Montjean
