Dear friends of Saints Peter and Paul and Philomena,

Advent, with its beautiful customs and distinctive liturgical usages, is one of the richest times in the whole Church calendar. This week we celebrate the third week of Advent which this year, because Christmas falls in the middle of the week, is also the last full week of Advent. The liturgy of the third week of Advent is marked by the winter Ember days, and the week before the Christmas vigil (17th to 23rd December) is marked by the greater ferias, dedicated to the so-called 'O Antiphons'. The Ember days are traditionally days of penance, and the texts of the winter Ember days naturally speak to us of the holy Mother of God: the Annunciation (Wednesday) and the Visitation (Friday). Dom Gueranger explains the beautiful O Antiphons this way: 'Every day, at Vespers, is sung a solemn antiphon, which consists of a fervent prayer to the Messiah, whom it addresses by one of the titles given him by the sacred Scriptures. There are seven of these antiphons ... They are commonly called the O's of Advent, because they all begin with that interjection. These antiphons are sung at the *Magnificat*, to show us that the Saviour, whom we expect, is to come to us by Mary.' The last week of Advent is called Sapieniatide, from the first antiphon, *O Sapientia* ('O Wisdom from on high, come!'). Why not come to Vespers one day this week, especially next Sunday, to hear them!
