Dear friends of Saints Peter and Paul and Philomena,

Our Lord Jesus Christ is a King – but an otherworldly king, and not a king like those of this world, as he reminded Pilate. His subjects are all of us, his legions are the angels, his Throne is next to His Heavenly Father (Apocalypse), his crown is the most precious one we can imagine, his life is permanently and eternally glorious. This description, inspired by the Liturgy of this solemnity, which is our Institute's principal feast, is detailed in the book of the Apocalypse, which also leads us to the Feast of All Saints next week: but, under these glorious symbols, our King deliberately chose to receive first a sorrowful royalty in His Passion: His crown was first made of thorns, His sceptre was a reed of fools, His army betrayed Him in the garden of Gethsemani. We are not above our King, and have all to pass through the sufferings of our life to merit a glorious reward. We would often like to contemplate and celebrate the glorious life of the King because we feel easier, probably more attractive, but we can't forget to accept the sorrowful part of the royalty. Celebrating this feast invites us to follow our King's life with Love, Hope and Faith: he will therefore reign in us, in our families, in our Church.
