The liturgical year is divided into two parts, which help to us relive the mysteries of Christ's earthly life: the cycle of the Incarnation (Christmas) and the cycle of the Redemption (Easter). Today we enter into the Easter cycle. Easter is the principal celebration in the Church year – the feast of feasts – and it is so important that it is prepared by a long season of preparation, which is itself divided into three periods: Septuagesima (remote preparation), Lent (proximate preparation) and Passiontide (immediate preparation). Today we enter the pre-Lent season of Septuagesima, which is a transition from Epiphanytide to Lent. The most striking fact about the liturgy in this season, aside from the violet vestments, is the total absence of the word *Alleluia*, which is omitted even on feast days, from now until the Easter Vigil. (Unlike in Lent, the organ is still played in Septuagesima, and the altar can be decorated with flowers: the Church wants to help ease us psychologically into the penance of Lent.) In the Roman liturgy, the *Alleluia* is a symbol of joy, since it is the song which the saints sing eternally in heaven (Apoc 19:1). The three weeks of Septuagesima remind us that this life is a time of exile from our true home in heaven, and so, 'how shall we sing the song of the Lord in a strange land?' (Ps 136:4). It is Christ's victory over death at Easter that will lead us into the Promised Land. – *Abbe Altieri*
