Dear friends,

The season of Lent is approaching and the liturgy of this Sexagesima Sunday, halfway through the pre-Lent season, reminds us of the importance of the sacrament of Confession: therefore, making a sincere and fervent Confession is the most effective way of preparing ourselves to live out the spirit of Lent. Our Pope Francis, in his latest general audience, stresses the importance of this sacrament, which allows us to receive at the same time God's life and authentic supernatural inner peace. Let us read these words from the Pope: 'Though the Sacrament of Confession is a great treasure, we may be tempted to dismiss it, perhaps due to laziness or embarrassment, or because of a diminishing sense of sin and its effects. Too often, we see ourselves as the centre and measure of all things, and our lives can go adrift. The Sacrament of Reconciliation calls us back to God, and embraces us with his infinite mercy and joy. May we allow his love to renew us as his children and to reconcile us with him, with ourselves, and with one another'.
