Dear friends of Saints Peter and Paul and Philomena,  
*Tota pulchra es Maria*, “Thou art all beautiful, O Mary”: this Sunday, we celebrate one of the main feasts of Our Lady, her Immaculate Conception. She was preserved from the stain of the original sin to become Our Lord’s mother. This great privilege reminds us of the particular place and mission of the Blessed Virgin Mary: she was created to be the living Tabernacle of the Divinity in the Mystery of the Incarnation. “He that made me, rested in my tabernacle” (Ecclus 24:12). The Institute of Christ the King is consecrated in a special way to the Immaculate Conception. We beseech Our Lady Immaculate to protect the priesthood and to highlight in the Institute the devotion to the Real presence of Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament. May the Immaculate Mary lead us to make a good, humble and true Confession during the Season of Advent to be made worthy of her Son.
