“This Christmas we (...) cannot fail to recognise that Christianity in our own country is under threat not by violence or widespread discrimination but by neglect and a growing ignorance highlighted in last week’s “ComRes” survey which found young, British adults confused between the Gospel and the story of Father Christmas. The former Archbishop of Canterbury, Lord Carey, warned here in Shrewsbury that Christianity in England is only ever one generation away from extinction. We are always a generation away from seeing the extinction of Christian faith in our own land if we fail to pass on the faith in its fullness to the generations who follow us. Christianity has been the most important element in England’s history, shaping our culture, institutions and laws and yet this bright light will fade unless we value anew the Christian inheritance. It will fade unless we are ready as a Christian minority in this land to give witness to our faith with the courage we see in so many Christians around the world. This is why we speak in the Diocese of Shrewsbury today and across the western world of a “new evangelisation”. A new and urgent announcement of the Gospel which Pope Francis reminds us brings joy. “The joy of the Gospel”, the Holy Father explains, “fills the hearts and lives of all who encounter Jesus” (*Evangelii Gaudium* n.1). It is the real joy of Christmas we are today in danger of losing (EG n.7)”.
