Dear friends of Saints Peter and Paul and Philomena,

The poet T.S. Eliot, shared by both sides of the Atlantic, memorably wrote, 'in my beginning is my end'. At the end of the liturgical year, as we prepare next week to begin the yearly cycle with Advent once again, this sentiment makes perfect sense to us, as does this line from the same set of poems: 'the end of all our exploring will be to arrive where we started and know the place for the first time'. Today's Gospel (Mt 24:15-35) for the *end* of the liturgical year, like next Sunday's Gospel (Lk 21:25-33) for the *beginning* of the next liturgical year, contains Our Lord's prediction of his final coming in glory at the end of time. Why this strange repetition of the same idea two weeks in a row, bookending the whole liturgical cycle? It is a reminder that the gentle babe of Bethlehem, for whose coming in the meekness of the flesh we prepare during Advent, will come a second time in power and might at the end of time to judge the living and the dead. By tying together one liturgical year as it ends with the next as it begins in this way, the Church reminds us of this essential truth of our faith. Already at the moment of his Incarnation, Christ – the Word made flesh – came to this world as its priest and king, from whom alone salvation comes. How are we preparing to meet him?
