Dear Friends of Ss Peter, Paul and Philomena,

“Lord, do that I may see !” : this request of the blind man of Jericho is a shout of Faith. Pope Benedict XVI invites us during this Year of Faith to ask this virtue as this inhabitant of Jericho. We are spiritually blind because we cannot see God in His Being : his external actions, like Creation, Sacraments, the Church, etc... help us to perceive a part of His perfection. All these signs are helpful, and feed our Faith. But there seems to be a contradiction: if God wants to give us signs of His presence and action in this world, I can see more aspects of His Being. If I see better, my Faith is less. The less I see, the more I have to believe ! Actually, when I discover the perfections of the Holy Trinity and the paths He uses to attract me to Heaven, my Faith is not sated : I need to know and love Him more. It is a light which leads me to discover another mystery in God : on this path I am always blind, and I always ask Him to see.

The blind man does not ask to see someone or something : he requested to see this mysterious way of salvation, to see the mysteries of the New Testament to reach his everlasting life.

This blindness is often a sorrow for us because we don't see or feel His sensible presence. It is the redemptive part of Faith by offering this weakness for the Love of God. May we see his Grace and his Love for us.
