Dear friends of Saints Peter and Paul and Philomena,

This summer, divine providence blessed the diocese of Shrewsbury with three newly ordained priests. Today we have the joy of welcoming Fr Edmund Montgomery, one of these new priests, to celebrate a High Mass of thanksgiving in honour of Our Lady of the Rosary (transferred from its feast day of 7th October). Speaking last summer to seminarians and religious novices, the Holy Father reminded them: *The labourers for the harvest are not chosen through advertising campaigns or appeals for service and generosity, but they are 'chosen' and 'sent' by God. For this, prayer is important.* This is a very useful reminder for all of us as well. Everyday here at the Shrine, at the end of Adoration, we ask Almighty God to 'send us many holy priests and religious vocations'. Especially during this month of the Holy Rosary, let us redouble our prayer for this intention in our family Rosary (in it is never too late to start the daily family Rosary if we do not already have this pious custom!), since, as many saints and popes have reminded us, the prayer of the Rosary has special power to touch the heart of Our Lord and His Immaculate Mother. First Blessings of a Newly Ordained Priest

After Mass Fr Montgomery will give his blessing to the faithful
This First Blessing is a pious act which confers a plenary indulgence upon the recipient. "Indulgences are the remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven. The faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains the indulgence under prescribed conditions for either himself or the departed. Indulgences are granted through the ministry of the Church which, as the dispenser of the grace of redemption, distributes the treasury of the merits of Christ and the saints" (*Compendium of the Catechism*, number 312).
