Illuminate the Dome of Home as a Beacon of Hope for Wirral

Following massive community support for Wirral Borough Council's Love Wirral Grant, we have engaged Davies Partnership to develop proposals.

The brief is... To illuminate the green copper dome at night but minimise 'Light Trespass' and 'Light Pollution' using energy efficient lighting which is easy to use and switched on only when required.

The proposal is... To install four, cool white, LED projectors, designed to project light only where required and a lifespan of at least 17 years, and aimed at the main Dome from the north and south to compliment the green of the copper. Sensors and timers will detect light levels to control output. In addition, further LEDs will be installed inside the Dome to shine through the high-level windows, showing there is activity inside. This will provide a lighting effect similar to St Paul's Cathedral in London.

The cost is... £40k. So far, we have raised **£11k**. All commercial funders have links on our website. We have **£29k** still to go!

The next step is... Negotiate planning permissions. Obtain **£29k** sponsorship from individuals and commercial business.

Dear friends,

Thank you very much for your great support to the Shrine: I am very grateful for your prayers, particularly in your families, to help the work of the Institute of Christ the King Sovereign Priest in the UK, following Divine Providence and the will of the Church.

After 18 months preparation with our architect, we began the building works for our first Heritage Lottery Fund project on 19th May 2014. As we know, the Shrine is not only a physical building but fundamentally establishes a spiritual link with the Divine Presence through the Liturgy of the Church. Our human project to restore this vast, beautiful building would not be possible without God's blessing. This is why we all work here to bring people to the Catholic Faith. This is the essential mission given to the Shrine by Bishop Mark Davies, and we humbly try to be faithful to this spiritual goal.

Various classes of Faith formation for both adults and young people, and daily Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, are indeed more important than work to restore the building, but both walk together, showing the Glory of God as we praise Him in the Divine Office and meditation. At the Shrine, we endeavour to mix daily Mass, Confession, Rosary and Benediction with the Institute's typical hospitality so that more and more people, including many priests, are drawn to share priestly friendship and so enrich their faith with the Truths of Holy Church.

It was a great joy to receive our Bishop on Sunday 4th May, when he gave the Sacrament of Confirmation to seven young people and celebrated the Mass in the main Church. Please find beautiful pictures of this important event on the Gallery of our new website www.domeofhome.org

In addition to the future spiritual activities at the Shrine, and following support from the local community, we would like to illuminate the dome of the church. This project, first proposed by Fr Mullins when he envisaged the hilltop basilica in the 1930s, agreed by Msgr Gilles Wach, Prior of the Institute and supported by Bishop Davies, will enhance the beauty of our church and eventually help people to discover God and His Church through this building.

Many visitors are impressed by the size, beauty and the presence of God at the Shrine. This is a grand project for a grand church. Donations are needed. I ask your help to realise this aim, for the glory of God and the salvation of many souls!
